ST. PAUL TOURNAMENT OF EXCELLENCE TOURNAMENT RULES

5 minute pre-game warm-up (minimum)

8 minute quarters

30 second timeout (5 per game)

1 minute between quarters

7 minute halftime

3 minute overtime (1 additional timeout)

Zones

A full court zone press may be used in the backcourt only. When the ball crosses the half court line, no zone is allowed.

Scorebook

Each coach must report to the score table to fill out their team roster prior to the 3rd quarter of the previous game.

Players/Coaches Conduct

A player or coach that receives two technical fouls in the same game is disqualified from that game.

Player Eligibility

No player is allowed to participate unless he/she is presently attending the school participating in the tournament and is playing on that particular team for the current season.

Basketball Size

Boys- Collegiate Regulation; Girls- Collegiate Intermediate

Three Point Rule

The three-point rule is in effect and a shot will count for three points when it is released from behind the high school three-point arc.

Running Clock

The coach of a team that is behind by 25 points or more at the end of the 3rd quarter may request a running clock throughout the 4th quarter. This decision is made exclusively by the coach of the team that is behind and must be made prior to the start of the 4th quarter. There will be no reversal of either choice (running clock or no running clock) once the 4th quarter has begun.

Full Court Press

A team may not full court press when leading by 20 or more points.



ST. PAUL TOURNAMENT OF EXCELLENCE TOURNAMENT DANCE DRESS CODE & RULES

Dear Coaches, Athletes, and Parents,

The dance for 7th & 8th grade players and non-players from participating schools (only) is planned for Saturday, February 15, 8:00 to 10:00 p.m. and is a very special event. In keeping with tradition, attire could be classified as semi-formal. Thus, the St. Paul Tournament Committee has adopted a dress code for that evening. Please read the following guidelines carefully and advise players before tournament weekend. Please note that the dance is free for players. There is a \$5.00 fee for all 7th & 8th grade non-players from participating schools. Players and non-players must have a signed permission slip (dance ticket) in order to attend the dance. No exceptions.

BOYS

- ❑ Dress shirt and slacks. Ties optional. Jeans, shorts, sweats or t-shirts are not acceptable.

GIRLS

- ❑ Slacks, skirts with classic shirts, or dresses. Unacceptable attire includes: jeans, shorts, t-shirts, midriff shirts, transparent tops, exposed spaghetti straps or sleeveless tops/dresses (it's okay to cover them with a sweater or other garment that will be worn throughout the dance), and tube/halter tops. Dresses and skirts must be below mid-thigh in length.

The tournament committee looks forward to sponsoring this event for the players and we know the players look forward to it as well. We are committed to doing what we can to ensure fun for all.

Please remember that we request at least two chaperones from each school be present at the dance from 8:00-10:00. In case of an emergency, each school should provide their chaperones with emergency contacts and procedures for each player.
